

Announcing: Elementary Art Instructor

Responsibilities of Employment:

The primary responsibilities of the teacher are to plan and implement a challenging and engaging age-appropriate art program for students in pre-school through 5th grade. Students should build a vocabulary associated with knowledge of basic art concepts, principles, and techniques, and have opportunities to learn and practice a variety of types or styles of art. In addition, students should learn about selected artists and famous works of art. Students should demonstrate greater skills and knowledge as they move from one grade level to the next.

The teacher is expected to establish a positive and encouraging classroom environment characterized by engaging college preparatory instruction and experiences. Instructional planning must align with and support the Saint James School curriculum standards for elementary art classes.

The teacher must function effectively in a technology-rich environment and integrate the use of a variety of tech tools and software into the learning process as appropriate.

Candidates should be prepared to work with each member of the elementary faculty and administration in a positive and collaborative manner. Teachers are expected to maintain the highest level of professionalism at all times in interacting with students, parents, and school personnel.

Requirements for Employment:

- Completion of a bachelor's or master's degree program in art or art education is required.
- Current valid teaching certification in art education is preferred.
- Experience teaching elementary art (pre-school through 5th grade) is required.
