

### **Advanced Placement® Overview and Results**

Saint James offers AP classes beging in the 9th grade. Students may take an unlimited number of classes for which they qualify, and are required to take the exam for classes in which they are enrolled. Students consistently score above the state and global averages. In May 2025, students completed 228 exams with a 92% percent pass rate of 3 or higher.
